



WITHDRAWAL OF INVITATION TO PROPERTIES / EVENTS POLICY



To ensure a peaceful, undisturbed environment conducive to spiritual meditation and joyful interaction respectful of all Sahaja Yogis and the teachings of Our Guru HH Shri Mataji Nirmala Devi certain standards of behaviour are required.

Apart from positive personal discussions with fellow Sahaja Yogis and any formal announcements by those responsible as part of a program or event, no-one is to make any announcements to the group in attendance.

Sahaja Yogis will not use any negative or disturbing language to individuals or to a group and will not make any critical comments, claims or insinuations about other individuals or groups while attending the property or an event covered by Life Eternal Trust Australia (LETA) insurance policies, or at any other time.

If there is a perceived problem, or if there are any questions of the other person/s concerned, they are to be approached separately and privately to discuss the matters. To accuse or make accusations about others in front of a group or create disturbances in any situation is totally against the basis of HH Shri Mataji's teachings and normal expected behaviour in the wider society and will be considered a breach of this Policy.

These types of disturbances only serve to damage the attention and spiritual growth of those involved and also importantly disturb the peaceful enjoyment of the Sahaja Yogis who just want to come together to mediate and enjoy the Collective vibrations.

Other unacceptable behaviour can include but is not limited to:

- Not respecting the maryadas and expected behaviour of Sahaja Yogis,
- Not adhering to Working With Children Check (or equivalents) requirements,
- Not adhering to requirements set out in LETA Policies including Bullying, Harassment, Physical Intimidation or Threats,
- Not fully respecting protocols for approaching and showing reverence to Her Holiness and Her rooms in Centres and Ashrams,
- Not respecting Sahaja Yoga properties and equipment,
- Anything else which can disturb the vibrations and attention,

Established Sahaja Yogis are automatically invited to attend properties, programs or events covered by LETA insurance. However, the above requirements are necessary to participate in Sahaja Yoga and those abusing or not adhering to the requirements may have their invitation to events withdrawn and be required to not attend.

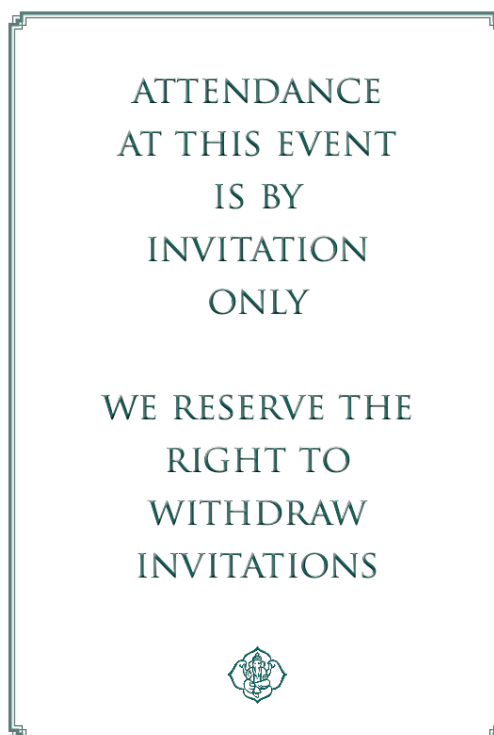
Should a breach occur, and the person/s involved be asked to leave the premises the person/s concerned will be advised with a letter referring to the WITHDRAWAL OF INVITATION TO PROPERTIES / EVENTS Policy and the reasons the action was taken with a copy of the Policy attached.

Should a breach of required behaviour guidelines in the WITHDRAWAL OF INVITATION TO PROPERTIES / EVENTS Policy be considered so serious that it requires the permanent

withdrawal of the invitation to attend LETA/LEPA properties or public venues covered by the LETA Public Liability Insurance Policy, the person/s concerned will be advised with a letter referring to the incidents and measures taken to try and address the breaches as an explanation of the decision with a copy of the Policy attached.

The peaceful, joy filled, mediative environment for the Collective is a requirement for all Sahaja Yogis.
